- 1) Enter your log in name and press <Tab>
 - 2) Enter your password and press <Enter>
 - 3) a) If a Login Results window shows up *close* that window by clicking on close
b) If a Set Windows Password window shows up click on cancel
 - 4) Double click on the *Ready to Program* icon
 - 5) Introduction to Java
 - a) In the Lab workbook read section 2.2 page 3 (do not do EXERCISE 2A)
Note: Whenever you are working on the computer and are referred to a book it will be the Lab workbook unless otherwise stated.
 - b) Read page 4 section 2.3
- II. A) Creating a new Java application (using the HSA console)
- 1) a) Read page 4 section 2.4
b) On the computer, on pages 4 & 5 section 2.4.1, do each of the steps marked with an arrow
Note: The book uses the term Boiler Plate but the computer uses the term Application Template
 - 2) Read page 5 section 2.4.2. Do not do the arrow instruction in this section.
 - 3) Read pages 5 & 6 section 2.4.3. Do not be concerned if you do not understand everything being explained in this section (further sections and lectures will be needed to fully understand all of it).
 - 4) Read page 6 section 2.4.4. Do not do the two arrow instructions in this section.
 - 5) On the computer, on page 6 section 2.4.5, do each of the steps marked with an arrow
 - 6) On the computer, on page 7 section 2.4.6, do each of the arrow steps below:
 - a) in the 1st and 2nd arrow: do not change the name Sue to your own name yet (make sure that the // has been also deleted in front of Place your program here .
 - b) Do the 3th and 4th arrow steps
 - c) Skip the 5th arrow step as you will be saving onto your H drive
 - d) Do the 6th, 7th, and 8th arrow steps
 - e) Do the 9th arrow step. After clicking the Run button (top left of the button bar) answer the following
 - i) The word Run on the button bar changed to what? _____
 - ii) The very top of the output console window (not the text area) says what?
